

## ORDER

This is in compliance with the directions dated 18.04.2018 passed by the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court in CWP No. 12863 of 2017 titled as Amit Bali & Others Vs State of Punjab & Others and in continuation of this office order no. 11385-99/A-2, dated 13.04.2018.


The matter has been examined in depth. There are 15 similarly placed constables including petitioners, working as Drill/MT/Riding Instructors at PPA, Phillaur who have completed 3 years of tenure as Instructor upto 31.03.2018 and are eligible for being considered for nomination for Lower School Course under Rule 19.22 PPR. There are no similarly placed constables at PRTC, Jahankhelan and CTC, Bahadurgarh who fulfil the eligibility criteria upto 31.03.2018.

The office of DGP, Punjab (Training Branch), vide its office letter no. 6247-48/Training-1 dated 09.04.2018 and letter no. 5650-51/Trg.-1 dated 28.03.2018, allocated a total of 1446 seats for 3 batches of Lower School Course meant for District Police and Armed Police to be run during the year 2018-19. Accordingly, each course would be for 482 constables approximately and the share of BPT candidates per course would be 120 @ of 25% as per PPR. Further, as per the 10% quota fixed vide this office order no.20146/A-2 dated 23.05.2017, a maximum of 12 constables can be nominated in each batch of Lower School Course under Rule 19.22 of PPR for the session 2018-19.

In view the of above, all 15 officials, including the petitioners, are allocated to the following batches of Lower School Course for the session 2018-19 as mentioned against their names as per their *inter se* seniority based on the criteria as laid down in this office order no. 220146/A-2 dated 23.05.2017:
